We do this through providing our own services and by facilitating the services of others. We do this work in solidarity with each other.
- We strengthen, develop and diversify the movement for the rights of people seeking sanctuary in Sheffield - We facilitate the development of the movement across the city and support people seeking sanctuary oppressed by systematic injustices to have their voices heard. We are a trusted and skilled organisation in the city and use our position to defend the rights of people seeking sanctuary.

We are committed to ensuring our members guide, shape and drive CoSS's work and priorities, wherever possible, which we believe makes the work we do more powerful and more impactful. One of our members have said:
