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About Us

We are London's first children's hospice. We were founded in 2000 by Anthea Hare, who saw that life-limited children and their families were not getting the care and support they needed.

Today, children and their families remain at the centre of our work. We provide support to over 300 families across London through a range of therapies and activities to support the whole family, as well as providing care for life-limited children.

We ensure that families receive the care and support they need, when and where they need it.

What we do

- ♥ **Respite care** giving families the opportunity to recuperate knowing their child is happy and cared for.
- ♥ **Hospice at Home** bringing care and support to the family home.
- ♥ **Therapies** such as art and music, helping children and their families to communicate.
- ♥ **Step down care** enabling families to be able to care for their child at home.
- ♥ **End-of-life care with pre and post bereavement support** supporting families to move through this very difficult time of saying goodbye.

Employee Benefits



Annual leave

All employees receive the equivalent of 27 days' annual leave per year excluding bank holidays (pro-rata for part-time and fixed-term contracts). This allowance increases to the equivalent of 29 days' annual leave after five years' service.

Pension

Richard House will contribute an amount equivalent to 7% of your annual salary to the pension plan, provided that you contribute 3%. You may also have the option to continue an existing NHS pension if you wish (subject to meeting criteria).

Life assurance

Provided that you are a member of the pension scheme, in the unfortunate event of your death in the service, a lump sum amount equivalent to two times your annual salary will be payable.

Employee assistance programme

Our EAP service provides a complete support network that offers expert advice and compassionate guidance 24/7, covering a wide range of issues. The service also provides access to face to face or telephone counselling.

Flexible working

We aim to work flexibly with all of our employees where possible. You can discuss the options around flexible working with your manager.

Enhanced maternity pay

If you have more than two years' service with us, we offer enhanced maternity pay. Further details are available in our Family Leave policy.
