Team leadership

- Support the Shop Manager to recruit, induct, manage, motivate, and train an inclusive and diverse volunteer team.
- Communicate effectively with both the Shop Manager and the shop team.
- Support the Shop Manager in maintaining Age UK's values and our commitment to safeguarding in all the shops activities.
- Provide a safe and healthy working environment and ensure that all staff are aware of and operate within Age UK's health & safety policies and procedures.

Shop floor

- Be actively involved in sourcing sufficient levels of stock locally working with the Shop Manager, shop team and the area team.
- Support the Shop Manager to set up and maintain efficient and effective stock processing systems, including back-room systems, ensuring Gift Aid is a priority.
- Ensure that the quality and safety of donated stock remains at a sufficiently high level and in line with Age UK standards.
- Collaborate with the Shop Manager to set high standards of cleanliness, display and merchandising for both donated stock and any new goods, ensuring that all legal and charity internal procedures regarding the sale of donated and new stock are adhered to.
- Encourage and expect excellent customer service of yourself and the Shop Team with regards to sales and donations.

Administration & Security

- Undertake any administrative and financial procedures as directed by the Shop Manager including banking, weekly returns, maintenance of petty cash account, and volunteer records.
- Ensure security of stock and cash on the premises reporting any shortfalls to the Shop Manager / Area Sales Manager.
- Accurately input required data into IT equipment within agreed timescales.
- Hold shop keys, opening and closing the premises for trading hours and responding to emergency call out when necessary.

Other Responsibilities

- In the absence of the Shop Manager work closely with the Area Sales Manager to ensure any problems in the shop are resolved quickly and effectively.
- Maintain absolute confidentiality regarding all charity information.
- Undertake any other appropriate duties as directed by the Shop Manager, Area Sales Manager and Divisional Sales Manager to achieve performance targets and realise the full potential of the shop.
- Attend and participate in meetings as and when required.
- Travel within the region where required in the performance of the job, to provide cover in another shop, or for training activities.

Must have's:

- Ability to work collaboratively and consultatively with the Shop Manager.
- Ability to lift and carry bags of stock up to 10kg's.
- Ability to lead a team of volunteers and staff.
- Ability to delegate and coach staff.
- Excellent customer services skills.
- Ability to manage time under conflicting priorities.
- IT literacy and numeracy skills.
- Able to lone work when needed.
