Key responsibilities

These include but are not limited to:

- Develop the high value prospect research strategy in support of the long-term fundraising ambition from high value audiences.
- Operationalise the high value prospect research strategy, bringing together key stakeholders in its delivery.
- Lead and carry out prospect research activity to meet the requirements of the relevant fundraising teams, including proactive research into new prospects, whether individuals, trusts, or companies, including leading prospect searches to match potential funders or sponsors to projects and events.
- Undertake mapping of prospect and Anthony Nolan's internal networks to further identify opportunities.
- Manage fundraising teams' suspect, prospect and supporter data, leading

prospect pool reviews and tracking movement.

- Create research profiles as needed to inform engagement with supporters and potential supporters.
- Prepare high quality briefs for senior leadership and others in advance of meetings and events.
- Devise and maintain a prospect management system that provides accurate reporting on prospects, managing the process for colleagues to share and record information following meetings, ensuring data quality, accuracy, and security.
- Undertake due diligence and corporate risk assessment on potential funders.
- Keep up to date with market and philanthropic trends and use this to inform our research approach.
- Act as high value lead on data protection and GDPR policies.
- Collaborate with the wider Philanthropy, Corporate, and Special Events teams and other colleagues to identify sustainable ways to deliver our current and future strategy.

Essential attributes

You will bring:

- Significant experience of managing prospect research with a focus on high-net-worth individuals, trusts and companies, and demonstrable knowledge of these audiences.
- Relevant experience of collecting and analysing research data, using a variety of sources, to produce high quality reports and recommendations.
- Experience of working with prospect management systems and using data management techniques to support the management of the prospect research process.
- Operational knowledge of the legal, financial and ethical issues related to individual, trust and corporate giving and prospect research.
- Experience of developing and managing relationships with senior stakeholders and ability to present research findings in an accessible format.

- Working collaboratively with colleagues across the charity as a whole, including senior leadership and trustees.
