ABOUT

Poetic Unity is a Brixton-based charity founded in 2015, we have delivered 1,421 services to 40,000 + young people across the UK to date in venues such as schools, prisons, youth clubs, theatres, and cultural spaces. We provide regular programmes focused on using poetry as a therapeutic tool for young people's mental health. Although we support young people from all backgrounds, we particularly support young people from Black and Black mixed backgrounds who are marginalised. Our team is Black led with lived experience of the young people we support and have over 10 years' experience of working with young offenders, marginalised young people, and children at risk. As an organisation that predominantly supports young Black people, the trustees are encouraging applications from candidates that are of Black or Black mixed heritage.

Programme Development and Management:

- Oversee the development, implementation, and evaluation of all programmes and services offered by Poetic Unity.
- Ensure programmes are effectively meeting the needs of the target demographic and are aligned with organisational objectives.
- Provide leadership and support to programme manager and foster a culture of excellence and continuous improvement.

Financial Management:

- Develop and manage the annual budget in collaboration with the board and CEO.
- Monitor financial performance against budgetary targets and implement strategies to optimise revenue generation and cost efficiency.
- Identifying and applying for funding opportunities such as grants, partnerships, and fundraising activities ensuring compliance with financial regulations and reporting requirements.

Interview third stage (deliver a task): w/c July 29th 2024.

All offers of work at Poetic Unity are made subject to receipt of satisfactory references and DBS checks. Additionally, under the Asylum and Immigration Act, we are required to check that anyone taking up employment with us has the legal right to work in the UK. All successful applicants will, therefore, be asked to provide us with documentary evidence to support their entitlement to work in the UK prior to taking up employment.
