# **ABOUT THE ROLE**

This is an exciting opportunity for a skilled writer and/or journalist to tell the stories of SAT-7 and the people of the MENA in fresh and powerful ways. You'll be working in a fast-paced, creative environment as part of the Communications & Resources Team, delivering high quality content across a range of platforms. You'd be writing engaging podcast and video scripts, informative press releases, powerful viewer testimonies, inspiring articles for our website or print magazine, political briefings, and attention-grabbing email copy. You'll be one of the main points of contact with our international office and Middle Eastern TV studios, gathering and repurposing impactful stories and resourcing the wider UK team.



You'd also be responsible for making SAT-7 more widely known amongst UK Christians and churches, leaders and influencers, getting SAT-7's stories and campaigns strategically placed across print, broadcast and digital press and media. Working closely with our external PR agency, you'll help facilitate regular media opportunities with SAT-7 UK and international spokespeople, making sure they are well prepared for interviews with the press.

All of this would support our 5-year strategic outcomes:

- 1. To see an increased and actively engaged support base giving regularly to sustain the work of SAT-7, so that SAT-7 UK is raising a sustainable £4M with over 3,500 donors.
- 2. Supporters and funders have a deepened understanding of the challenges faced by Christians and the people of the MENA region, and impact of SAT-7, to create opportunities to pray, engage and partner for change.

# **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Write engaging content for a range of platforms, in line with our "Read, Listen and Watch" strategy
- Demonstrate the life-changing impact of SAT-7 and the value of supporters' financial giving
- Show how God is at work in the MENA, and mobilise increased prayer for the issues affecting different people groups and MENA Christians
- Inform supporters and the wider public about the context, news, challenges and opportunities for the MENA region and Church

#### Core communications

- Working with an external writer, produce a monthly Briefing long-read article, summarising key news and events from the MENA region and adding in Christian context and SAT-7 stories as appropriate
- Adapt the monthly Briefing article into a 7-minute podcast script and facilitate recording
- Write and develop the Briefing email, sourcing strong press images to illustrate key stories
- Develop a new interview-style podcast, informing listeners about the MENA, telling strong stories and highlighting regional issues and Christian context
- Act as sub-editor for Insight magazine to supporters, writing effective and inspiring copy to demonstrate the impact of SAT-7 and inspire supporters to take action
- Work closely with the digital communications team to develop strong contextual content for X (Twitter) and LinkedIn
- Repurpose written content from SAT-7's international office, for use across a range of platforms
- Gather news and contextual information to generate content for flagship supporter publications, and support other teams as required (e.g. for events, campaigns, appeals, church presentations, prayer updates and reports)
- Assist the Communications & Resources Manager and other senior colleagues as required

#### Press and PR

- Highlight the issues and challenges of the MENA Church and region, and position stories in the UK press, media and churches
- Facilitate press interviews with SAT-7's UK and international spokespeople
- Contribute to the development of an organisational-wide thought-leadership strategy
- Work closely with our PR agency, to publicise and promote SAT-7 and its work, by providing key
  messaging, newsworthy stories and content for press, media and influencers
- Where appropriate, to manage SAT-7's ongoing relationships with press and media, including managing press contacts, actively seeking media opportunities, and writing press releases and articles
- Contribute to the development of our approach to advocacy, new NGO partnerships /
  collaborations, shared events and campaigns, as part of the outworking of the current strategic
  plan.

## Spiritual leadership

- Live by Christian standards in the workplace and lead by example
- Attend UK and international devotions to hear updates and spend time in prayer and worship together
- Lead occasional devotions and share spiritual reflections with the team
- Be open to presenting about SAT-7 in a variety of church, Christian, and media settings
- Be committed to SAT-7 UK's vision, mission, values and beliefs
- Maintain your own spiritual development and relationship with God, e.g. through church fellowship, individual prayer and Bible reading.

#### **WORK CONTEXT**

- The Communications & Press Officer role is office based (Chippenham) with some opportunities for home working.
- The role may involve some occasional travel across the rest of the UK, e.g. attending events or visiting SAT-7's Persian TV studio in London, plus occasional opportunities for travel overseas e.g. Vision Trips and/or Partnership Gathering.

- A passion for telling the stories of God at work in people's lives
- A degree-level qualification in Communications, Journalism, English, Politics or a similar field
- A talented writer with a portfolio of published written work
- Experience of working in a communications or journalism role, plus knowledge of UK press and media (Christian and secular)

- A fast worker, able to prioritise and multitask a number of ongoing projects to set deadlines
