- 1. Maintain and continue the development of a reporting application for Choose Love grantees, including various data collection and management databases and dashboards (80%):
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to gather requirements and translate them into comprehensive solutions.
- Design, develop, and deploy web applications and websites using no-code platforms like Bubble.io and Airtable.
- Create and manage Airtable bases, tables, extensions, automations, and API integrations.

- Develop and maintain modules using JavaScript, particularly for Airtable extensions and automation.
- Utilise Vercel to host Next.js applications and manage deployment processes.
- Integrate and manage asset delivery via Cloudinary and handle email functionalities using Postmark.
- Employ GitHub for version control and code management.
- Optimise existing applications and websites to enhance performance and user experience.
- Conduct testing and debugging to identify and resolve issues.
 Provide technical support and guidance to team members as needed.
 Stay current with the latest trends and advancements in no-code development tools and techniques.
