First Days was started in 2013 in response to needs in the local community in Berkshire. Quite simply: there were people with stuff they didn't need and people who desperately needed it. The charity grew very quickly and now, over 11 years later, we have a small staff team and an army of volunteers. We support around 4,000 children and their parents, every year. Alongside the distribution of essential items to families, we provide emotional and peer support to parents, as well as specialist coaching. We centre our work around restoring choice, dignity and power to people who have had these human rights taken from them.

Our aim for the charity is very clear: we want to close our doors because no one needs our service anymore. At the moment, that feels like a long way off. This is where you come in ...
