The Willesden Area Director of Ministry leads the Area Ministry Team. The postholder is responsible for fostering vocations, directing ordinands, overseeing clergy reviews and development, facilitating training programmes and managing the Area IME2 delivery.

As a senior member of the Willesden Area Team, the Area Director of Ministry will also contribute to strategic planning and implementation of ministry objectives within the Area.

This challenging role demands attention to multiple projects. The successful candidate will receive support from the Ministry Team, report to the Diocesan Director of Ministry, and collaborate with the diocesan and Willesden Area team. You'll have administrative and team support to help you flourish. The Willesden Area Ministry Team includes Assistant Area Directors of Ministry (AADOs), Area Director of IME2 (ADI) lay and ordained discernment assessors, and MDR consultants.

The Willesden ADM serves as the Diocesan Portfolio lead for Clergy Well-Being. Collaborating with The Bishop's Adviser to the Bishop of London, they work with other Area Directors of Ministry (ADMs), the London College of Bishops, and diocesan and Area colleagues, to create a strategic vision and processes to implement improved Clergy Well-Being across the diocese.

The ideal candidate should have experience in vocational discernment and pastoral care, demonstrating effective individual connections. Experience in consultative work with colleagues and self-direction in prioritising tasks is valued. Commitment to working with diverse theological traditions within the Church of England is essential.
