Express Plus 1:1 Arts Therapy

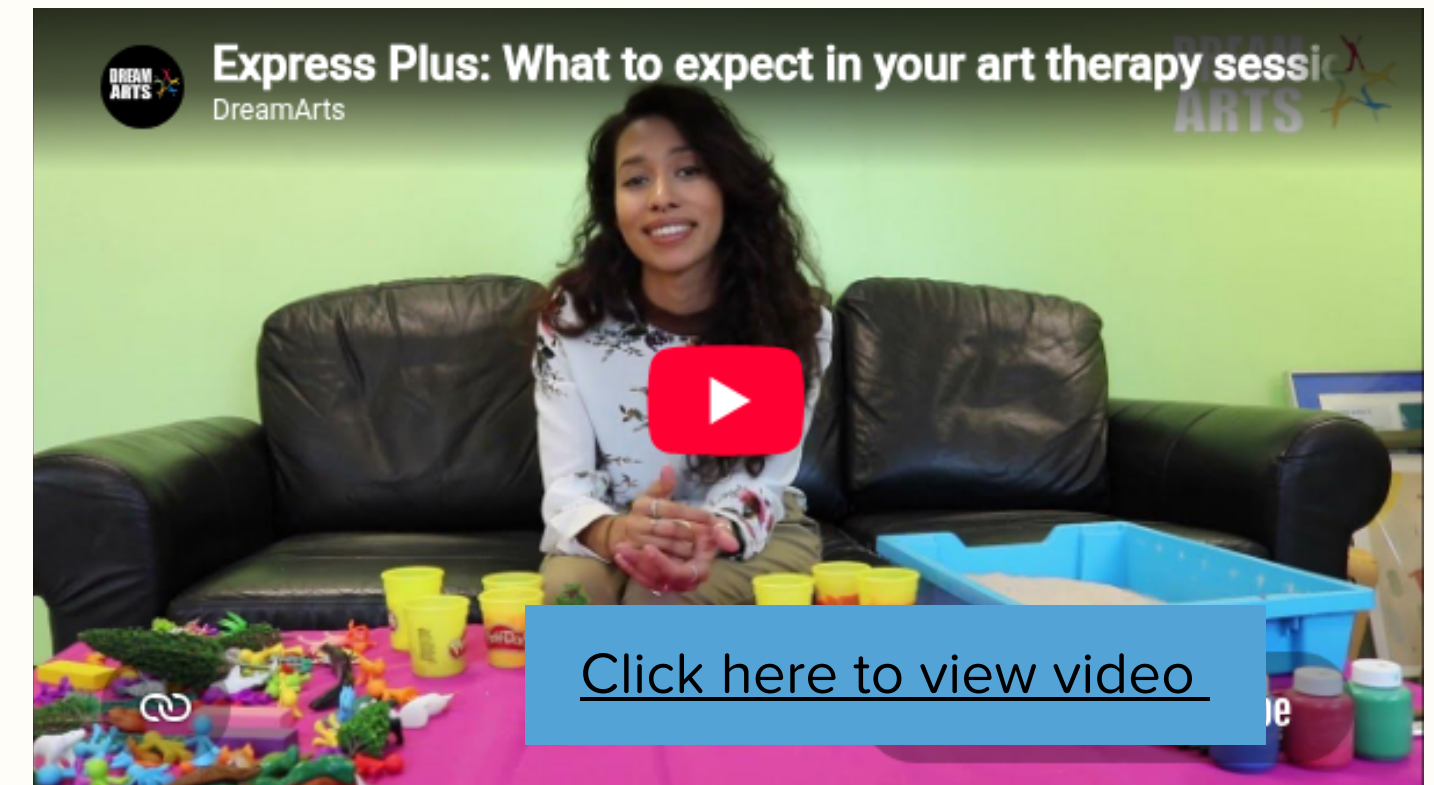

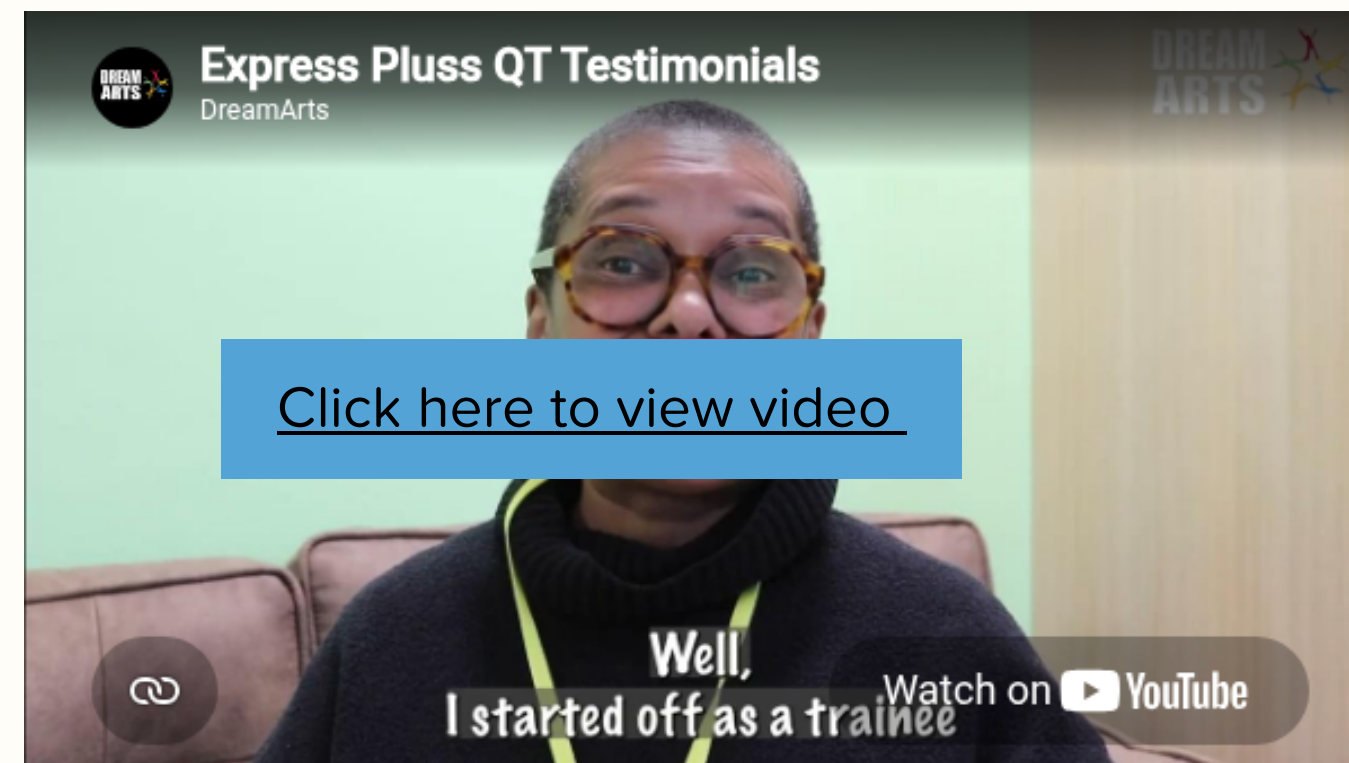
