#### This role involves:

- Working as part of a small team to engage our family visitors with fun and entertaining days out, making meaningful connections to wetland wildlife and Welney.
- Bringing to life self-led activities and seasonal events throughout the year; from pond dipping and bug hunting, to bird watching and owl pellet dissection!
- Helping the team to plan, prepare, run and feedback on seasonal holiday events and WWT national events and trails, as further opportunities for connecting people with our wetland wildlife.
- Supporting our staff with delivering other special events, such as bats and barn owl evening walks, and guided walks.
- Helping staff and other volunteers with occasional media-related activities and other opportunities for enhancing engagement for audiences.
- Taking due care for the safety, welfare and enjoyment of the visiting public, especially children.
