The recruitment process consists of an application via Applied.com as well as an online assessment centre.

Month 1: Settling In

- Three weeks of onboarding training with your cohort.
- Focus on networking, understanding upReach, and social mobility.
- Allocation of Associates and employer or university partners by week 3.
- First session with external Leadership training provider, The Circle Line
- Allocation of first rotation.

Month 2-6: Finding Your Feet

- Settling into your role, getting to know Associates and partners.
- Join Virtual leadership development training every six weeks.
- End of six months: in-person training focusing on Partnership Management and Programme Coordinator skills.
- Continue to build your skills on your allocated rotation

Month 7-12: Growing in Confidence

- Start your second six-month rotation in a new area of the charity.
- Engage in development discussions with your managers, with the potential to apply to become a Programme Leader at the one year mark
- In-person training with a focus on Project Management & Risk Assessing

Month 13-18: Developing as a Leader

- Third six-month rotation in another new area.
- Opportunity to begin studying for a formal qualification
- (e.g., Leadership apprenticeship).
- In-person training in Programme Management
- The opportunity to develop evidence to apply to become a Junior Programme Manager between 18 and 24 months

Month 18: Beyond the FCLP!

- Chose to stay at upReach and continue on a journey of progression by applying to Junior Programme Manager or Programme Manager
- Join another charity with the experience gained at upReach, you are well placed to join at Manager level
- Start your own charity!
