ROLE DESCRIPTION:

We are looking for a proactive and relationship-focused **Fundraising Development Manager** to support our Fundraising Director in growing our fundraising across a range of areas including trusts, donors, events and community fundraising. You will play a key role in building meaningful supporter relationships and helping deliver engaging fundraising activity, contributing both ideas and hands-on support to help our work flourish.

You will be part of a growing charity making a real difference to families, working in a varied role with opportunities to develop across different areas of the charity, within a supportive and collaborative team.

Whilst there isn't a genuine occupational requirement for the post holder to be a practising Christian, the successful candidate for the role will need to commit to working in line with Restore Hope's core values, and Christian ethos.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **Support delivery of the fundraising strategy**
Work closely with the Fundraising Director to implement fundraising plans across a range of income streams, helping to maintain momentum and meet income targets.
- **Build and steward donor relationships**
Develop and maintain positive relationships with donors and supporters, ensuring they feel valued, informed, and connected to the impact of their giving.

- **Coordinate trust and foundation applications**
Support the research, writing, and submission of funding applications, as well as reporting back to funders in a timely and engaging way.
- **Assist with fundraising events and community activity**
Help plan and deliver events and community fundraising initiatives, working with supporters and volunteers to create successful and enjoyable experiences.
- **Manage and maintain CRM data (Salesforce)**
Ensure accurate and up-to-date records of donors, communications, and fundraising activity to support effective relationship management and reporting.
- **Support major donor engagement**
Assist in identifying, engaging, and stewarding major donors, including helping to coordinate meetings, communications, and follow-up activity.
- **Work with volunteers and wider team members**
Provide support and coordination to volunteers and colleagues involved in fundraising, helping to keep activity organised and aligned.
- **Ensure good fundraising practice and compliance**
Follow appropriate processes around data protection, due diligence, and fundraising standards to ensure all activity is carried out responsibly. To actively contribute to the prayer & worship life of the charity.
- To undertake any other task that is reasonably required by the charity.

You will be an experienced fundraiser who enjoys working as part of a team and supporting a range of fundraising activity.

You are comfortable building relationships, managing multiple priorities, and getting stuck into practical delivery when needed.
