About the Role

The part-time (21 hours) Community and Events Fundraiser will raise the profile and awareness of CamSight and increase income through developing and securing a range of funding streams including individual supporters, challenge events, community, and digital fundraising. The post holder will help to develop and ensure the effective delivery of the community fundraising strategy in relation to generating sustainable income from third parties, brand campaigns and challenge events.

The role will help grow our portfolio of events, working collaboratively to explore ideas and launch new initiatives to help us achieve our mission. The role plays an important part in helping us to meet our fundraising targets by increasing participation and community engagement in our events and fundraising activities.

We are also currently recruiting for a part-time (21 hours) Corporate and Partnerships Fundraiser but would welcome applicants interested in a full-time role (35 hours a week) covering both job descriptions. If this is of interest, please make this clear in your covering letter.

Specific Tasks

General

- Work alongside the Head of Business Development and Corporate and Partnerships fundraiser to develop and promote successful and engaging fundraising initiatives, campaigns, and events to engage and encourage potential supporters, using research to spot trends and popular initiatives.
- Develop and follow processes and systems to ensure the effective management of all relevant information, including maintaining and taking responsibility for accurate information on the charity's database and the community and challenges section of the website.
- Analyse the potential risks and benefits of fundraising events/activities considering risk, time/cost ratios, and overall ROI, to focus effort accordingly.
- Ensure all associated activities are compliant with charity law, regulatory requirements, and best practice, including the Data Protection Act and GDPR.
- Be a positive ambassador for CamSight, promoting and raising awareness of its services and delivering engaging fundraising presentations to potential and existing supporters.
- Be an active and supportive member of the Fundraising Team and wider CamSight team, contributing to the team's development and working collaboratively with colleagues to maximise cross-working opportunities.
- Work collaboratively with the Marketing and Communications Officer to develop and implement marketing and social media plans for all events/activities.

Community

- Responsible for developing a calendar of community fundraising events and campaigns and to engage people to take part in and support these.
- Reach new audiences in our local communities across Cambridgeshire to take part in and facilitate fundraising activities.
- Attract new support and nurture and develop existing support by providing excellent stewardship to maximise supporter journey, value and retention and in-turn income.
- Manage relationships with individuals who approach CamSight wanting to make donations or raise funds for us in a timely and supportive way.
- Write and present Funding Bids to a range of suitable community grant providers.
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• Research new potential funders using all appropriate methods to ensure suitability of bids and maximum return on investment.

Challenge Events

- Responsible for developing a calendar of Challenge Events and engaging individuals and teams to take part.
- Recruiting volunteers to support and facilitate Events.

Finance

- Support the development and implementation of a fundraising plan to maximise income generation across the designated area, in line with the overall fundraising strategy.
- Contribute to the development of annual income and expenditure budgets, monitoring results and contributing to regular reforecasts, mitigation, and contingency planning to ensure targets are achieved.

CamSight responsibilities
