Our work creates a positive distraction, reduces isolation, improves self-esteem and creates precious memories and smiles.

Wishes - The wishes we grant are as unique as the children themselves and whether a child wants to be a fireman, meet a real-life mermaid or even the Loch Ness Monster, we work hard to make that wish come true.

Wish Community - From the moment a wish is granted, children and their families become part of this community, and are invited to join in any of the events which take place throughout the year – across the UK.

Job Title: Major Gifts & Partnerships Executive

Key Responsibilities

Partnerships

- 1. Support with creating proposals and pitches to secure Brand, Corporate and Commercial Partnerships, with a strong focus on shared purpose and mutual benefit, to create successful long term strategic partnerships.
- 2. Support with relationship management of current partners of Rays of Sunshine, ensuring they have materials to aid their fundraising.
- 3. To manage the input of corporate partnership data on the CRM system (currently Donorfy).
- 4. Manage the updates to the corporate pipeline master document, ensuring appropriate actions are met within deadline.
- 5. Supporting the Corporate Volunteer Researcher to undertake the necessary research to support our pipeline of approaches.

Philanthropy

- 6. Creating supporter updates and reports to demonstrate the impact of funding received from our Patrons and Major Donors, providing excellent stewardship to existing donors.
- 7. Provide support with the event planning of major donor events, and attend in person to provide support of events on the day.

Trusts and Foundations

8. Support with research and the successful completion applications to secure donations from a pipeline of identified Trusts and Foundations.

9. Identifying new opportunities to create wow moments for donors and provide excellent stewardship of all major donors and partnerships.

General

- 10. General administrative duties, including record meeting notes and actions, following up with partners, sending out of promotional materials, monitoring and responding to email enquiries, and taking telephones calls.
- 11. Any other duties to support the success of the fundraising team.

Person Specification

- Previous experience of working with corporate partnerships would be ideal, but candidates with experience in major donor, trusts and foundations or special events would be desirable
- 2. Able to demonstrate how your experience in one or more of these income areas, as supported the team's fundraising success.
- 3. Previous experience of supporting the development work of a fundraising pipeline.
- 4. Experience of creating proposals, presentations and completing funding applications.
- 5. Experience of providing excellent stewardship and supporter care to donors.
- 6. Experience of supporting with event planning and providing on the day support at events
- 7. Articulate and able to communicate with passion, to describe the work of the charity and story tell.
- 8. Organised and works well to deadlines, with ability prioritise responsibilities according to need.
- Ability to proactively use a database and establish an effective means to monitor a pipeline within a CRM (we use Donorfy) and report on outcomes.
