**As a Christian Aid Media Volunteer, you'll help tell powerful stories that challenge poverty and injustice.** You'll build your skills and confidence in media work while helping Christian Aid reach new audiences and inspire action.

Working alongside staff and local supporters, and supported by our Media and PR Advisor, you'll turn real experiences into compelling stories for mainstream and faith media—using words and images to shine a light on issues that truly matter.



## How will I make a difference?

- You'll share powerful local stories that show how Christian Aid supporters create change.
- Capture moments from events that bring our work to life.
- Give supporters a voice by listening to their experiences and turning them into engaging stories.
- Raise awareness by helping local media share stories that matter.
- Build positive local media connections that help more people hear about Christian Aid.
- Promote dignity through ensuring every story is shared ethically and with clear consent.

## What skills I do need?

- Ability to write clearly and confidently in English (for Wales, bilingual skills are a real bonus)
- Confident talking with people, helping them feel at ease.
- Working independently and managing your time.
- Using good judgement to spot and flag sensitive stories when needed.
- Staying organised to keep track of stories and opportunities.
- Thinking creatively while staying aligned with Christian Aid messaging and guidance.
- Photography skills aren't essential, but they're welcome if you have them.

## How will I be supported?

- A named member of staff offering regular 1-1 support.
- A welcoming induction and training to help you get started.
- You'll be part of a caring team, helping each other.
- Ongoing updates through our quarterly volunteer e-newsletter.
- Learning about our voice, brand and ethical storytelling.
- Reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses.

## What about location and time?

- You'll be able to volunteer from home, with the possibility of attending events if you wish.
- You can expect to spend a few hours each month with us. It's busier in May, in the run up to Christian Aid Week.
