This is an exciting time to join an ambitious team who will raise funds for the UK's first centre of its kind.

Gympanzees is seeking a dedicated and resourceful Networking Fundraiser to join our team. This role is pivotal in expanding our network of supporters, donors, and partners to generate crucial funds in support of our mission. The ideal candidate will excel in building relationships, leveraging connections, and fostering collaborations with individuals and organisations passionate about promoting Gympanzees. This position offers an exciting opportunity to play a key role in driving fundraising efforts through strategic networking initiatives.

At Gympanzees, we offer a working environment that enables everyone to perform their best with flexible hours and remote working options to suit your home life. The role is hybrid with time split between our office at Aust and home working. We are open to discussing working patterns that work best for you whilst keen for you to be an active team member.

Main Responsibilities - include but are not limited to.

- **Stakeholder Engagement:** Cultivate and maintain relationships with existing and prospective donors, sponsors, and community leaders, effectively communicating Gympanzees' mission, impact, and funding needs.



- **Donor Cultivation:** Develop and implement personalized strategies to steward donors, including regular communication, donor recognition, and engagement opportunities tailored to their interests and preferences.
- **Partnership Development:** Collaborate with businesses, foundations, community groups, and other stakeholders to establish strategic partnerships, sponsorship opportunities, and cause-related marketing initiatives.
- **Fundraising Campaigns:** Support the development and execution of fundraising campaigns, including major gifts, corporate giving, and peer-to-peer fundraising initiatives, leveraging networking connections to expand donor participation and reach fundraising goals.
- **Event Support:** Assist in the planning and execution of fundraising events, providing networking support to secure sponsorships, donations, and attendance, and actively engaging attendees to cultivate relationships and drive fundraising results.

- **Collaborative Approach:** Work collaboratively with the fundraising team, marketing department, program staff, and executive leadership to align networking activities with organizational priorities, fundraising goals, and strategic initiatives.
- **Continuous Learning:** Stay informed about trends, best practices, and emerging opportunities in fundraising and networking, seeking professional development opportunities to enhance skills and knowledge in the field.

- Strong interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to engage and inspire diverse audiences and articulate Gympanzees' mission and impact persuasively.
