



Background

The Hackney and Islington Programme is a catalyst programme that galvanizes growth across the Hackney and Islington boroughs through fostering strategic and sustainable partnerships and church plants, resulting in a mixed ecology of churches that are increasingly young, culturally diverse, impacting low-income communities, and seeing a renewal of catholic mission. As part of this ambition, a number of new church partnerships have come together in 2025. To enable these partnerships to flourish, the Partnerships Operations Project Manager will initially support St Stephen's Canonbury with St Jude's and St Paul's partnership, and St Mary's Stoke Newington with St Andrew's Bethune Road partnership.
