### Responsibilities

- Lead on discovery of certain datasets at RDS, working with data controllers to assess
  the feasibility of using their data and working to agree full process from initial
  contact to data preparation.
- Lead on securing specific datasets identified within the ADR Scotland data sourcing process for processing by the analysts.
- Lead on the implementation of improvements to digitising the data sourcing processes and standardising process documentation.
- Work with data controllers to agree access for research to priority datasets.
- Work to ensure the efficient running of processes around how data should be cleaned, prepared, updated, and quality assured so that it can be brought together with data from different sources.
- Support the operational planning and delivery of research ready datasets for the ADR programme.
- Support the overview of the datasets within the pipeline, in preparation and being ingested into the data catalogue.
- Identify and support team members to adapt and improve existing models of data ingest as required.
