Role title: Peregrine Watch Volunteer

Purpose of your role: If you have a particular passion for birds of prey then this is an opportunity to share your passion with others. Tasks you will be involved with:

We are looking for volunteers who want to organise and operate a small display tent that invites people to use telescopes to view peregrines from a distance.
