- Ensure timely and suitable interaction with potential new business partners
- Arrange and lead within meetings and presentations to prospective new partners
- Be creative and innovative in generating funds from corporate partnerships including contributing to bids, proposals and pitches

- Lead on ITF's corporate due diligence process
- Ensure effective systems for onboarding of new corporate partners
- Renegotiate contracts with existing partners in liaison with relevant colleagues

- Produce reports on performance against income targets and prospect pipeline
