Background

The Group the Musical is a disability theatre academy with registered charity status in Shrewsbury (UK). It was founded by Heidi Brown, Dan Woodvine, Chloe Parry and Natalie Weller, all with background in performing arts and working with people with disability.

The theatre academy was founded to perform a musical written by Dan Woodvine which raises awareness of autism and disability, and offer an inclusive theatre academy to adults and young people with disability and people from the community of Shropshire.

Teaching Assistant Role

The Group the Musical is seeking a teaching assistant to offer support to adults and young people during drama, music and dance sessions for one or two evening sessions per week. This would be a wonderful and rewarding opportunity to work with young people and/or adults with disabilities to support them to learn new performance skills. Under the direction of the Director and other members of the team they would offer assistance in the full sessions and one-to-one support to adults who require this. This would be an ideal position for any candidates with existing experience or background in working with people with disability or special education or seeking to gain experience in this field. There would also be the opportunity to learn new performance skills though background in performing arts is not required.
