Coram's Fields, a unique children and young people's charity in the heart of London, is seeking passionate and committed individuals to join our Board of Trustees (Non-Executive Directors).

Founded in 1936, Coram's Fields provides a safe haven for children and families, combining a seven-acre park and playground with a wide range of community services supporting children from birth through to early adulthood. Each year, we welcome over 250,000 visitors and work directly with around 2,000 children and young people - many facing disadvantage, including poverty, overcrowded housing, and limited access to safe outdoor space.

As we enter our 90th year, our commitment to supporting the needs of local families whilst growing our reach and impact locally, continues to drive all that we do. This includes a focus on strengthening our long-term financial resilience, and investing in our historic Grade II listed estate, both of which are essential foundations of our work in the community.

Trustees play a vital role in shaping this future - providing strategic oversight and support to the Executive Team.

Coram's Fields has always been, and remains rooted in the community it serves, and we are seeking Trustees who share our passion and commitment to improving the lives of children, young people and families locally.

You don't need to be a seasoned Trustee to apply for the role – in fact we welcome applications from those with little or no experience of being a Trustee and particularly welcome those with lived or professional experience of the issues we try to address through our work.

Alongside this, we have also identified certain skills gaps within our Board that we are keen to fill including; finance, fundraising, legal, marketing and communications, third sector and facilities and estates. This list is though not exhaustive and we welcome applications from people with a range of skills and experience - A commitment and alignment to our values and a desire to contribute to our work is something we are looking for above anything else.

This is a voluntary role requiring approximately 8–10 days per year, including Board and committee meetings. Trustees are appointed for an initial four-year term.
