We have all felt lonely from time to time, but for 50,000 residents in Oxfordshire, this feeling is enduring, with seemingly no end in sight. At Archway, a registered charity with 43 years' experience of providing support to alleviate the hurt and distress, we refuse to let this continue. Using our incredible network of volunteers, we run a series of services for people across Oxfordshire to tackle loneliness and isolation.

Anyone over the age of 18 in Oxfordshire who identifies as lonely and/or isolated may be eligible for our services.

Key Responsibilities:

- **Governance and Strategy:**
 - Contribute to the development and implementation of the charity's strategic plans.
 - Ensure the charity complies with its governing document, charity law, and other relevant regulations.
 - Safeguard the charity's values and reputation.
- **Fundraising:**
 - In partnership with the Income Generation Group and CEO, develop and implement a comprehensive fundraising strategy.
 - Support fundraising events and initiatives.
 - Provide regular updates to the Board on fundraising activities and progress.

- **Financial Oversight:**
 - Work with the Treasurer and Board to ensure the charity's financial stability.
 - Work with CEO to monitor and evaluate fundraising performance against targets.
- **Advocacy and Networking:**
 - Act as an ambassador for the charity, promoting its mission and values.
 - Build and maintain relationships with key stakeholders, including donors, partners, and the community.
