About City Harvest

Since 2014, City Harvest has been rescuing food to feed people and protect the planet.

People across the UK are experiencing unprecedented levels of food poverty. The cost-of-living crisis caused food prices to increase by 25%, and 8 million people are now food insecure. Many families who have previously never had to worry about where their next meal was coming from are now struggling to put food on the table. With so many families pushed into food poverty, more people are turning to food banks and charities.

At the same time, one-third of the food produced in the UK never reaches a plate. The London food industry throws away enough surplus food to create 13.3 million nutritious monthly meals, more than enough to feed every person struggling to eat in the city.

City Harvest solves food poverty and food waste across London. **Every week, we rescue over 100 tonnes of surplus food from the food industry. Our staff and volunteers sort and package this food, and our vans deliver it, free of charge, six days per week to over 375 community partners across 30 London boroughs**. We provide over 1.1 million meals monthly, and 43% of our deliveries are fresh fruit and vegetables.

Key Deliverables

Fundraising research, proposal writing and income generation

- Work with the Senior Trusts and Foundations Manager to deliver City Harvest's ambitious targets for Trusts and Foundations income in 2024/5 and beyond.
- Build a strong pipeline of new donors who have the potential to support City Harvest, with a focus on those previously unknown to the charity.
- Proactively research and explore new avenues for funding, ensuring the most effective approaches are made
- Prepare and deliver targeted funding applications to trusts and foundations (including corporate foundations), working closely with key organisational stakeholders.
- Develop, maintain, and tailor a template application for comprehensive submission to smaller trusts and foundations.
- Work with the Senior Trusts & Foundations Manager to develop fresh, up-to-date content and insights for applications and reports.

Donor reporting and administration

- Maintain ownership of trust and foundation accounts, as agreed with the Senior Trusts and Foundations Fundraising Manager.
- Meet all monitoring and reporting requirements for donors efficiently.
- Ensure internal systems and processes are kept up to date for strong donor management.
- Develop effective record-keeping systems to support reporting to donors.
- Work with the Communications and Community Impact teams to maintain an up-to-date bank of City Harvest stories and case studies for use in fundraising applications and updates.
- Manage Trusts & Foundations leads from other teams, establishing criteria fit and keeping them updated on progress.

Build positive relationships with funders

- Build and maintain strong relationships with key stakeholders at trusts and foundations.
- Support colleagues in engaging appropriately with funders, providing briefs and background information.
- Support the leadership team in building individual relationships with key donors where appropriate.

Strategy & planning

• Work with Senior Trusts & Foundations Manager & Head of Fundraising to develop an organisational case for support and a range of highly fundable initiatives for City Harvest.
