Your support means we can provide end of life care, symptom management, short breaks and respite care. We can also be there to support parents and siblings through their bereavements.

Bereavement and Wellbeing

Rainbows has a strong commitment to supporting the wellbeing of our volunteers. For this reason, we ask that volunteers leave at least two years after the bereavement of a baby, child or young person before applying to become a volunteer.

If you are a relative of a baby, child or young person who is currently accessing our services or has accessed our services within the last two years, there may be restrictions on what volunteer opportunities you can apply for. If you want to discuss this further, please contact the Volunteering Team.

Requirements

To be able to volunteer at the Hospice, you must be over the age of 18 years old. To volunteer at our retail shops or in event and fundraising you must be over the age of 16 years old.
