Key Responsibilities

- Edit and refine audio recordings for clarity, consistency, and professional quality.
- Integrate background music and sound effects to enhance storytelling and engagement.
- Work closely with podcast producers to align audio with the narrative and mood of each episode.
- Apply noise reduction, balancing, and mastering techniques to ensure a polished final product.
- Collaborate on creating a consistent sound identity across podcast episodes.

Skills and Experience

- Proficiency in audio editing software (e.g., Audacity, Adobe Audition, Logic Pro, etc.).
- Experience with sound design, music integration, and mastering techniques.
- An ear for detail and a passion for creating high-quality audio content.
- Ability to collaborate with producers to align audio with the episode’s tone.
- Prior experience in podcast production or sound editing is a plus.
