About Us

Legasee is a small UK-based charity committed to preserving the stories of British military veterans through our extensive digital video archive. Our mission is to make these personal histories accessible to everyone, ensuring the voices of those who served are heard for generations to come. To broaden the reach of our archive, Legasee has begun weaving together veterans’ stories into themed podcast series that offer unique and personal insights into life as part of the British military. The first series of *The Veterans’ Voice* featured D-Day veterans; we’re looking to create podcasts on other themes and conflicts experienced by veterans in the archive.

The Opportunity

We’re seeking skilled volunteer podcast producers to join our team and help create new episodes for *The Veterans’ Voice*. You’ll have the chance to research our archive, including newly collected interviews from the Women’s Royal Army Corps (WRAC) and veterans from conflicts such as the Falklands War or Cold War warriors, and turn that research into informative and engaging themed podcast episodes.

Key Responsibilities

- Research veteran interviews and thematic content from our archive.
- Conduct additional historical research to provide context and depth to episodes.
- Develop podcast scripts and story arcs that are both engaging and accurate.
- Incorporate feedback from the team and revise scripts through multiple drafts to ensure high-quality content.
- Contribute to the editing and production process to help create polished, high-quality episodes.

Skills and Experience

- Experience in or a strong interest in podcast production and storytelling.
- Comfort with historical research and working with audio content.
- Strong organisational skills, creativity, and attention to detail.
- Prior experience with audio editing software (a plus but not essential).

Training and Support

You’ll receive support and guidance from team members who were involved in producing our first podcast series. Full training on our archive and the podcast production process will be provided.
