THIS IS YOUR RECOVERY JOURNEY...



RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT

(Up to 24 weeks on-site)

- Counselling
- Keyworking
- Groups
- Work/training (e.g. in the kitchen, grounds or building maintenance, vehicle repair)
- Optional: One-to-one Christian discipleship, 12 Step meetings, IT courses, on-site hobbies and activities such as gym, fishing, sports, art and music

SEMI-INDEPENDENT LIVING

(Up to 24 weeks on-site)

- Continuing counselling and keyworking
- Groups
- Voluntary work in the community
- Developing independent living skills (e.g. cooking, cleaning, laundry) within a shared flat

SUPPORTED ACCOMMODATION

(Approximately 12 months in local community)

- House share with other abstinent residents
- Keyworking
- Opportunities to engage in education, training and employment



We will help you, but you are the driving force. If you have the desire, perseverance and willingness to learn and change, you can enjoy a lifetime of positive recovery.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

YES

All our accommodation comprises single occupancy rooms, with en-suite bedrooms in the Main House

YES

Smoking and vaping are allowed

YES

You can have visits from appropriate family and friends

YES

You can go out on leave according to our programme rules

YES

Many helpful medications, such as anti-depressants, are allowed

YES

Subsidised places may be available if you're struggling to get funding
